He is responsible for recruiting and overseeing the preparation of officer candidates through a comprehensive college program at Tennessee State University and 11 cross-town universities.

Lieutenant Colonel Cash was commissioned in 2006 through the AFROTC upon graduating from Middle Tennessee State University in Murfreesboro, TN. Lieutenant Colonel Cash is a graduate of the Air Force Legislative Fellowship Program where he served as the Defense Legislative Fellow for the Chairman of the Defense Subcommittee on Appropriations, Representative Peter Visclosky.

He has also served as Commander of the 50th Comptroller Squadron and as the Chief of comptroller officer assignments.
