This letter is to inform you that any time you are participating in an event that you will be using temporary structures such as a tent and/or propane gas as a method for cooking on public or private property, you are required by law to obtain a required permit form the Nashville Fire Prevention Office. Below you will see the codes that are used that supports the requirement for obtaining a permit.

105.1.1 Permits required. Any property owner or authorized agent who intends to conduct an operation or business, or install or modify systems and equipment which is regulated by this code, or to cause any such work to be done, shall first make application to the fire code official and obtain the required permit.

105.6.27 LP-gas. An operational permit is required for:

- 1. Storage and use of LP-gas. Exceptions: A permit is not required for individual containers with a 500-gallon (1893 L) water capacity or less or multiple container systems having an aggregate quantity not exceeding 500 gallons (1893 L) serving occupancies in Group R-3.
- 2. Operation of cargo tankers that transport LP-gas.

105.6.43 Temporary membrane structures and tents. An operational permit is required to operate an air-supported temporary membrane structure or a tent having an area in excess of 400 square feet.

Exceptions:

- 1. Tents used exclusively for recreational camping purposes.
- 2. Tents open on all sides, which comply with all of the following:
 - Individual tents having a maximum size of 700 square feet 21
 - 2.2 The aggregate area of multiple tents placed side by side without a fire break clearance of not less than 12 feet shall not exceed 700 square fect total
 - 2.3 A minimum clearance of 12 feet to structures and other tents shall be provided.

Please note that if you are found in violation by using a temporary structure or cooking with propane without a proper permit, you are subject to being issued a citation and given a court date. At that time you will be responsible for court cost including court fees and additional fees from our office before you will be issued any other permits to be used in Davidson County. If you have any questions, please contact our office.

All Propane being used without a permit application will be charged a triple fee of \$75.00.

Tents, canopies or membrane structures and their appurtenances shall be adequately roped, braced and anchored to withstand the elements of weather and prevent against collapsing. Documentation of structural stability shall be furnished to the fire code official on request.

This does not relieve the applicant of the responsibility of obtaining permits required by any other Metro or State agency.
