Bills will not be mailed and will be available through your myTSU account beginning, April 27, 2017 (Class schedules will be deleted if fees are not paid or students must confirm registration if their fees will be covered by scholarships, authorized deferments and/or financial aid by 4:30 p.m. at Cashier Window or by 6:00 p.m. on myTSU, online payments only). Early Registration for TBR, UT, State and TSU employees. Fee waiver forms can only be honored for classes selected on or after April 10, 2017 for Maymester and May 8, 2017 for TN eCampus/Full/1st Summer sessions and June 12, 2017 for 2nd Summer session . Completed forms should be submitted beginning April 3, 2017 via fax, mail or in person prior to the fee payment/confirmation deadline to prevent class schedules from being deleted. Students are encouraged to better plan their schedules and retain their full-time status on their way to a timely and successful graduation.</p> <p>Students dropping and adding a class on or after the first day of classes must process both the Add and the Drop ON THE SAME DAY and the Add must be processed first.</p> <p><i>TN eCampus</i> courses cannot be evenly exchanged with TSU courses when students drop/add on or after the first day of classes. <p>Financial Aid Refunds disbursed.</p> <p>Refunds will be available for students beginning June 5, 2017 who have registered, completed all paperwork in the Financial Aid Office, confirmed that they will be attending for the term on myTSU, and have actual aid credited to their accounts. Direct deposit is required if you are a freshman, transfer, or a returning student. All students are required to sign up for direct deposit. Direct Deposits may take up to three business days to post to bank account. Students who do not sign up will receive their refunds via checks mailed to their permanent addresses on file, beginning June 25, 2017. To sign up, log on to myTSU and select <i>Student</i>, then <i>Refund Account Information</i>. If parents have secured Plus loans (and the refund will be returned to them) or if your financial aid is <i>Authorized</i> or <i>Memo</i> (i.e., pending), you must make other arrangements for books.</p>	<p>Beginning June 5, 2017 Direct deposits may take up to three business days to post to bank account.</p>
