Academic Advisement

All students with 0-59 College Level Credit Hours Earned must receive advisement by the Advisement Center, prior to registering for courses. These students should be aware of the following regarding their accounts:

- **Course registration restrictions have been placed on all student accounts with 0-59 college level credit hours earned**
- **Once these students are advised by the Advisement Center the course registration restriction will be cleared temporarily for course entry and placed back on their accounts each semester until they earn at least 60 hours of college credit.**
- **Students with 60 or more college level credit hours should go to their major department for advisement**
- **Advisors will be available for walk-in visits for registration Monday, Nov. 12, 2012 – Tuesday, Nov. 20, 2012 in Room 234 (the Auditorium) in the Student Success Center (formerly LRC)**
