ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- YOUR Cumulative GPA **MUST** BE AT LEAST 2.5 IN THE FOLLOWING COURSES: a) CHEMISTRY 151, 151L OR CHEMISTRY 1110, 1111; b) CALCULUS I, MATH 163 (1910); c) CALCULUS II, MATH 164 (1920); **AND** d) GENERAL PHYSICS, PHY 221(2110), 221L (2111) AND PHY 222(2120)
Note: A grade of "D" is unacceptable in any of the above courses.
- Your application will **NOT** be accepted without a copy of your current Tennessee State University ID and your most recent transcript.
- Your application **MUST** be submitted to the Dean's Office at least 7 days (1 week) prior to the EEE date. Failure to do so **MAY** result in your **NOT** taking the test on the next scheduled date.
- Departments will **assign** each student to a **session time** if application is approved.
- A NEW APPLICATION MUST BE COMPLETED EVERY TIME YOU WISH TO TAKE THE EEE!**

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- All students must present a signed copy of the form and a current TSU I.D. (with picture and ID Number) for admission into the Engineering Entrance Examination Room.
- This is a closed book, closed note examination.
- You must have a score of 64% and above in each section (mathematics, physics and chemistry) and also for the whole test to pass (**both requirements** must be met to pass).
- Only those students passing the engineering entrance exam will be allowed to take 300 – 400 Level Engineering Courses.
- You should arrive at the test site **15 minutes before the exam start time** and bring the following items: 1) Your copy of the approved application for the EEE; 2) TSU I.D. Card; and 3) One calculator (calculators cannot be shared). Pencils and erasers will be provided by the testing center.
- No cell phones or smart watches are allowed.**
