Application Process

• STEP-1:

Complete the online application form for the <u>Turkey 2015</u> Program via <u>www.tncis.org</u> website.

• STEP-2:

Pay \$100 application fee. Please stop by the Office of Diversity and International Affairs (ODIA) and speak to a Study Abroad Advisor to obtain a payment form to take to the TSU Bursar's Office for paying your application fee. The ODIA is located in Crouch Hall Suite 106.

Apply Early and Save \$100!!! Eligible students with completed applications by December 3, 2014 (including paid nonrefundable \$100 application fee) will receive acceptance notification by December 10, 2014 and a \$100 discount off the program fee. The deadline for all other applications is February 12, 2014.

• STEP-3:

Request an official transcript from TSU registrar or records office. Only official transcripts will be accepted. If you are in your first semester of studies and have no grades at the time of your application, you must still request an official transcript from your registrar to demonstrate you are currently enrolled in credit bearing coursework at a TBR institution. Please have the transcript sent in a sealed envelope to this address:

• STEP-4:

Ask a faculty member to submit an online recommendation for you via https://www.tncis.org/study abroad/online recommendation form.aspx website

STEP-5:

Complete and submit your application for a TSU Study Abroad Grant. <u>This grant could provide up to 50% of your program cost.</u> This application will be done via the TSU ODIA website. Please stop by the ODIA to learn how to apply for this grant.

• STEP-6:

Talk to your financial aid advisor. Federal and State financial aid can cover some of the cost of approved study abroad programs. You will need to meet with your financial aid advisor to discuss your financial aid profile. Note that TnCIS courses are considered regular summer courses at TSU and you may utilize your financial aid *in addition to* the Study Abroad Grants as described in STEP-5.
