## **Eligibility CRITERIA**

- U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Underrepresented minority transfer students from community college
- Accepted into full-time BS degree program in the TSU College of Engineering (engineering and CS)
- GPA: 3.0/4.0
- Demonstrate financial need

## **Scholarship Benefits**

- Up to \$10,000 per year costof-education allowance for tuition and fees for two-years
- PROMISE summer bridge program, professional development seminars, and mentoring.
