GPA Requirements
I understand that I must have a cumulative TELS GPA of at least 2.75 after 24 and 48 TELS attempted hours, and a 3.0 or higher after 72, 96 or any subsequent multiple of 24 semester attempted hours.
I understand that if I have less than a 3.0 GPA but at least a 2.75 GPA after the 48 hour benchmark that I must enroll full-time and have a minimum 3.0 semester GPA to continue receiving lottery funds. Subsequent semesters will require the same enrollment status and semester GPA until I reach another 24 hour benchmark with a cumulative 3.0 GPA. I understand that any credits gained through dual-enrollment, AP credit, or other test credits do
not count in my TELS GPA. I understand that all classes taken after high school graduation count in my TELS GPA, including repeated classes which TSU may exclude from my institutional GPA. I understand that my TELS GPA and TELS attempted hours may differ from my TSU GPA and attempted hours, due to the above differences. I should check with the Lottery Scholarship Coordinator frequently to determine my progress.
I understand that I may exercise a one-time only Repeat Option to exclude the grade of one repeated course from my TELS GPA. I must notify the Financial Aid Office of my request to use this option by submitting a Repeat Option Request Form, available in the Financial Aid Office. I understand that I may use a one-time only Regain Option to regain eligibility for the TELS award, if I lose the scholarship due to GPA but meet the GPA requirement at a future bracket, and continue to meet all other continuing eligibility criteria for each semester. I must notify the Financial Aid Office of my request to use this option by submitting a Regain Option Request Form.
ime Limits
I understand that I may receive a Tennessee Education Lottery Scholarship for up to 5 years from my initial enrollment or until I receive a bachelors degree, which ever occurs first. I understand that if I received a Tennessee Education Lottery Scholarship for the first time during the fall 2009 term or thereafter, that I become ineligible once I reach 120 hours attempted depending on degree.
