DESCRIPTION

- The Tom Joyner Foundation and Tyson ٠ Foods, Inc. will work together to initiate the 2014 TScholars Project. The scholarship and internship arrangement with four historically black colleges/universities which were targeted by Tyson Foods, Inc. because of their proximity to Tyson company facilities and the availability of students majoring in Agriculture and Business.
- 12 Winners will be named the week of July 7, 2014. Each will receive a \$2500 scholarship.
- Funds will be awarded for the 2014 fall and 2015 spring semesters, provided the GPA requirement is maintained.
- Winners will participate in hunger-related community service projects with Tyson plant staff.
- Mentored internships for the summer 2015 ٠ will be coordinated and facilitated by Tyson Foods based on
 - Qualification of the scholarship applicants and
 - Availability at Tyson Foods plants and corporate office.
- The TScholars Project ends July 31, 2015.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE AND HOW DOES IT WORK?

- Open to all sophomore or junior level students at these four HBCUs majoring in agriculture or business
- Students must be enrolled full time and be in good academic standing (2.75 GPA or better)
