## **Introduction**

The History ePortfolio Writing Prizes recognize the best written ePortfolio artifacts created by students in HIST 2010, HIST 2011, HIST 2020, and HIST 2030.

Essays of at least four pages prepared in these courses on any historical subject – including both topical papers and book reviews – are eligible for consideration.

## **Prizes**

First Place – \$100

Second Place – \$50

All Nominees – One 1GB Flash Drive

## **Nomination Process**

Any faculty member teaching the Sophomore History Survey may nominate one student per course section to be considered for the award.

To qualify, a student essay must have been submitted and evaluated on eLearn (elearn.tnstate.edu) and included in the student's ePortfolio at the time of the nomination.










Nominations should be made by email to Dr. Erik Schmeller ([eschmeller@tnstate.edu](mailto:eschmeller@tnstate.edu)) by **Wednesday, April 30**, and should include:

- (1) the name of the nominated student, (2) the student's email address, and
- (3) the title of the student's essay.

## **Selection and Award Process**

Nominated students will be contacted by email immediately following the receipt of nominations and requested to share their ePortfolio essays with the members of the prize selection committee.

The prize selection committee will review the nominated essays online and announce first and second-place winners by **Wednesday, May 7**.
