1. ALL STUDENTS MUST CHECK INTO HIS/HER ROOM WITHIN TWENTY-FOUR (24) HOURS OF THE OPENING OF THE RESIDENCE HALLS/APARTMENTS. STUDENT MUST NOTIFY THEIR HALL DIRECTOR IF THEY CANNOT CHECK IN WITHIN 24 HOURS.
2. ALL MOVES REQUESTED WITHIN THE RESIDENCE HALLS WILL BE MADE BY THE RESIDENCE HALL DIRECTORS UPON HIS/HER APPROVAL BASED ON AVAILABILITY.
3. EACH RESIDENT SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR DAMAGE TO OR LOSS OF ANY UNIVERSITY PROPERTY IN HIS/HER ASSIGNED ROOM. DAMAGE TO THE PUBLIC AREAS IN THE RESIDENCE HALL WILL RESULT IN A GROUP ASSESSMENT WHEN THE INDIVIDUAL(S) RESPONSIBLE IS/ARE NOT IDENTIFIED.
4. A CHARGE OF \$58.00 TO RE-KEY THE ROOM WILL BE IMPOSED IF ROOM KEY IS LOST OR NOT RETURNED DURING CHECK-OUT FOR THE RESIDENCE HALLS. A CHARGE OF \$50.00 WILL BE IMPOSED IF FOB (KEYLESS ENTRY DEVICE) IS LOST OR NOT RETURNED DURING CHECK-OUT. UNAUTHORIZED DUPLICATED RESIDENCE HALL KEYS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
5. COOKING IN THE RESIDENCE HALLS IS RESTRICTED TO THE KITCHEN AREAS PROVIDED BY THE UNIVERSITY.
6. ALL RESIDENCE HALL/HOUSING RESIDENTS ARE SUBJECT TO AND MUST COMPLY WITH THE UNIVERSITY'S CAMPUS LIVING GUIDE, RESIDENCE LIFE POLICIES, STUDENT CONDUCT CODE, AND APPLICABLE STATE AND FEDERAL LAWS.
