1. **STUDENTS MUST CLAIM HIS/HER ROOM WITHIN TWENTY-FOUR (24) HOURS OF THE OPENING OF THE RESIDENCE HALLS/APARTMENTS. STUDENT MUST NOTIFY THEIR HALL DIRECTOR IF THEY CANNOT CHECK IN WITHIN 24 HOURS.**
2. ALL MOVES REQUESTED WITHIN THE RESIDENCE HALLS WILL BE MADE BY THE RESIDENT HALL DIRECTORS UPON HIS/HER APPROVAL BASED ON AVAILABILITY.
3. EACH RESIDENT SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR DAMAGE TO OR LOSS OF ANY UNIVERSITY PROPERTY IN HIS/HER ASSIGNED ROOM. DAMAGE TO THE PUBLIC AREAS IN THE RESIDENCE HALL WILL RESULT IN A GROUP ASSESSMENT WHEN THE INDIVIDUAL(S) RESPONSIBLE IS/ARE NOT IDENTIFIED.
4. A CHARGE OF \$275 WILL BE ASSESSED TO THE STUDENT'S ACCOUNT FOR APARTMENT KEYS THAT ARE LOST OR NOT RETURNED DURING CHECKOUT. A CHARGE OF \$50.00 WILL BE IMPOSED IF FOB (KEYLESS ENTRY DEVICE) IS LOST OR NOT RETURNED DURING CHECK-OUT. UNAUTHORIZED DUPLICATED RESIDENCE HALL/APARTMENT KEYS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
5. COOKING IN THE RESIDENCE HALL IS RESTRICTED TO THE KITCHEN AREAS PROVIDED BY THE UNIVERSITY.
