### **ALL RESIDENTS MUST LEAVE THEIR ROOM/BATHROOM CLEAN**

#### **ACTIONS TO BE TAKEN BEFORE CHECKING OUT**

1. Discard all food and perishable items. Place all trash in the outside trash dumpsters
2. Residents must leave their room/bathroom clean
3. Residents are responsible for securing all personal items. Residents are strongly encouraged to remove valuable items
4. Return all campus property to cafeteria, library, etc.
5. Close and lock all doors, windows and blinds
6. Unplug and defrost refrigerators and unplug all electrical appliances
7. Leave heating on low

1. Complete a License Cancellation Agreement Form <http://www.tnstate.edu/housing/forms.aspx>
2. Remove all belongings from the room/apartment
3. Have the hall/apartment staff check the room/apartment
4. Sign/return the key and fob in the front office and complete appropriate paperwork
