WHAT IS A PELL GRANT?

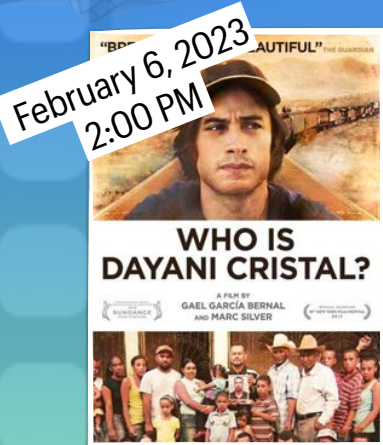
Federal Pell Grants usually are awarded only to **undergraduate students** who display exceptional financial need and have not earned a bachelor's, graduate, or professional degree.
