PSYC 3180 Computer Applications and Technical Writing (3). <u>Prerequisites</u>: PSYC 2180 and Upper Division Admission.

PSYC 3210 Abnormal Psychology (3).

PSYC 3230 The Psychology of the Black Experience (3).

PSYC 3300 Physiological Psychology (3). Prerequisite: Upper Division Admission.

PSYC 3310 Principles of Human Sexuality (3).
