Activities at the host University include conducting laboratory research and interacting with local faculty and students during week days and visiting historical and natural sites near the city during weekends.

- o A current or past Level I undergraduate TLSAMP student presently enrolled
- Interested in Agricultural Science/biology/chemistry/
- o Interested in the culture of Honduras and networking with the people

How to apply:

- o Complete an application form
- Write a brief statement of your interest and experience
- Provide two letters of recommendations

Research Projects:

- The focus of this research experience is tropical agriculture and the role that a central American country plays in supplying the world with tropical foods.
- Students will learn about and participate in the production of tropical fruits and vegetables, including propagation, planting, management, and harvest.

Selection will start by March 30 and selected scholars will be notified By April 15, 2016.
