

NURSING ACADEMIC MAP: DEGREE BSN (120 CREDIT HOURS)

This degree map is a semester-by-semester sample course schedule for students majoring in Nursing. The milestones listed to the right of each semester are designed to keep a student on track to graduate in four years. The schedule serves as a general guideline to help build a full schedule each semester. Milestones are courses and special requirements necessary for timely progress to complete a major. When one or more milestones are missed, students should consult with an academic advisor to determine if another degree path would be more suitable.

The BSN Program is a limited access major with specific entrance requirements prior to the junior year. The overall Grade Point Average (GPA) through the December or May prior to application to upper division nursing is the GPA reviewed for entrance into upper division nursing courses. The minimum overall GPA prior to December is 3.5 on a 4.0 scale. Entering applicant pool for the BSN Nursing Program does not guarantee admission to BSN Program. Each applicant must take the pre-entrance nursing examination through the TSU Testing Center and earn the academic preparedness level of Proficient or above. BSN Admissions Committee generally selects applicants for the program by mid-May for a Fall admission cohort or mid- November for a Spring admission cohort. The offer of admission to upper division BSN courses is contingent upon applicant meeting the July 1st or December 15th deadline for submission of health information documents and the required BSN Program learning contract. Consult TSU Undergraduate Catalog regarding the statement on required criminal background check and urine drug screen reports as well as the additional health and insurance information required by the clinical agencies. Nursing majors may not have any "D"s in any course; all earned grades must be C or higher. Science course requirement: Students must earn a Grade of "C "or above on the first attempt at taking any of the required science courses. If the student earns a "D" or "F" in any of the required science courses [regardless of retaking courses] then student is not eligible for BSN admission. All required general education and nursing prerequisite courses [61 credit hours] must be completed by the end of TSU Summer I term for Fall admissions or end of Winter Break for Spring admissions, following the submission of the application. There must be no more than two courses remaining to take in the terms stipulated. Consult with BSN Department in the fall prior to the year of planned application to BSN Program regarding updates to admission guidelines.

Tennessee State University recognizes that students have diverse learning, life, and professional experiences. The University provides opportunities for students to earn college credit in the general education requirements toward the BSN degree through a number of assessment options that evaluate their learning experiences. These paths are grouped under the category "Prior Learning Assessment" (PLA). Various means of earning PLA credit at TSU are the following: Advanced Placement Program, American Council of Education (ACE) Military Credit, College Level Exam Program (CLEP), DSST Credit by Examination Program (includes DANTES Examination), Institutional Course Challenge Exams (Departmental Exams), International Baccalaureate Credit, Other Military Service, Portfolio Assessment.
