

HIGHLIGHTS OF RALPH BOSTON'S CAREER



Ralph Boston is considered one of the greatest athletes the world has ever known. Boston won a gold medal in the 1960 Rome Olympics where he broke Jesse Owens' 24-year Olympic record, a silver medal in the 1964 Tokyo Olympics, and a bronze medal in

the 1968 Mexico City Olympic Games. Boston is a Tennessee State University and U.S. Olympic Hall of Fame inductee; and,

- ◆ **1962** - Earned a bachelor's degree in Biochemistry from Tennessee State University
- ◆ **1974** - Inducted into the U.S. Track and Field Hall of Fame, the Olympic Hall of Fame and the National Black College Alumni Hall of Fame
- ◆ **1985** - Received the NCAA Silver Anniversary Award

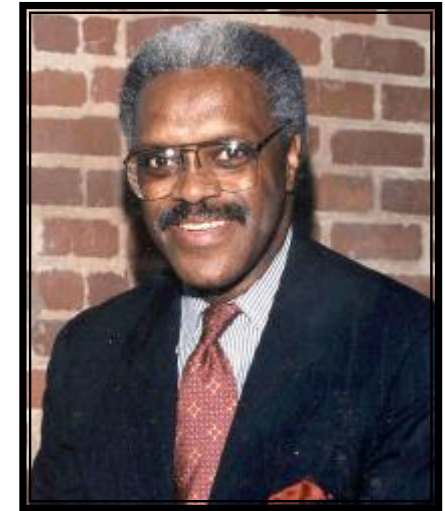
