the 1968 Mexico City Olympic Games. Boston is a Tennessee State University and U.S. Olympic Hall of Fame inductee; and,

- 1962 Earned a bachelor's degree in Biochemistry from Tennessee State University
- 1974 Inducted into the U.S. Track and Field Hall of Fame, the Olympic Hall of Fame and the National Black College Alumni Hall of Fame
- 1985 Received the NCAA Silver Anniversary Award


