## **How Do I Vote in Tennessee?**

- Voter Eligibilty
- How do I update my voter registration information?
- What ID is required when voting?
- Where do I vote on Election Day?
- How do I request an absentee ballot? registration or download a Tennessee voter registration application and submit the application to your local county election commission.

In order to participate in an election, a qualified voter must be properly registered no later than thirty (30) days before the election.

The election commission office will process any voter registration form that has been **postmarked at least thirty (30) days before the election.** 

Once you are registered, tell your friends on social media by printing a sign and posting your photo with it using the hashtag **#GoVoteTN**. You can print it in **color** or **black and white**.
