Regents Online Degree Program 2014-2015 Fees

Regents Online Degree Program (RODP) courses are charged per hour and are charged **separately** from TSU courses. Registration fees for RODP courses are computed in **addition** to registration fees for TSU courses and do not apply to the full-time maximum for TSU registration fees. RODP courses will not even-exchange with TSU courses when dropping and adding after the term begins. RODP classes can be identified by section number **R50**. RODP students are not required to pay the Program Service fee.

<p>Orientation Fee - \$40.00</p> <p>This one-time fee is charged to first-time students enrolled for 12 or more hours for credit in a semester; or 6 credit hours if first enrollment occurs in a summer term; or enrolled with an accumulation of 36 credit hours if the students has never been assessed the fee.</p>
<p>International Student Fee - \$30.00 per semester, \$0 Summer</p> <p>This fee is charged to students classified as international who are enrolled for credit courses, including audit courses.</p>
<p>College of Business Course Fee - \$25.00 per credit hour</p> <p>This fee is charged for all Business courses, except Business Orientation, Principles of Economics, and Introduction to Statistical</p>
<p>College of Engineering Course Fee - \$25.00 per credit hour</p> <p>This fee is charged for all Engineering courses, except Engineering Orientation.</p>
<p>College of Health Sciences Fees</p> <p>Nursing Course Fee - \$25.00 per credit hour</p> <p>This fee is charged for all AASN, upper-division, and graduate Nursing courses.</p> <p>Health Information Management Laboratory Fee-\$75 per lab course</p> <p>This fee is charged for HIMA 2030, HIMA 2350, HIMA 2400, HIMA 3010 and HIMA 3300 courses.</p> <p>Physical Therapy Reservation Fee - \$250.00</p> <p>This nonrefundable fee is charged for a reservation and is credited to tuition upon enrollment in the program.</p> <p>Occupational Therapy Reservation Fee - \$250.00</p> <p>This nonrefundable fee is charged for a reservation and is credited to tuition upon enrollment in the program.</p> <p>Cardio Respiratory Care Sciences Clinic Fee - \$75.00 per clinical course</p> <p>This fee is charged for Cardio-Respiratory clinic courses.</p> <p>Dental Hygiene Clinic fee - \$75.00 per clinical course</p> <p>This fee is charged for Dental Hygiene clinic courses.</p> <p>Dental Hygiene Laboratory Fee- \$30.00 per course</p> <p>This fee is required for DHYG 1030, DHYG 1110 and DHYG 1040 courses.</p> <p>Dental Hygiene Mannequin Rental fee - \$50.00 for pre-clinic laboratory</p> <p>This rental fee is charged to Dental Hygiene students for mannequins for pre-clinic laboratory.</p>

<p>Science Laboratory Fee - \$25.00 per course</p> <p>This fee is required for all Biology, Chemistry and Physics laboratory courses.</p>
<p>Book Bundle Fee - \$365.00 per semester/\$70.00 per course</p> <p>This total fee is charged for digital textbooks to students registered for 12 to 16 credit hours of general education core courses. The per-course rate is charged to students registered for less than 12 hours. Students taking more than 16 hours of general education core courses will be assessed \$365 plus \$70 per additional course.</p>
<p>Books and supplies are additional out-of-pocket expenses. These expenses should not be included with payments for tuition and other related expenses. Such expenses may range from \$800 to \$1,100 per semester, depending on a student's major and class load.</p>

TBR EXPLANATION OF MANDATORY FEES

Maintenance Fee	An "enrollment" or "registration" fee calculated based on the number of credit hours for which the student enrolls.
Out-of-State-Tuition	A fee charged to students classified as non-residents of the state of Tennessee who are enrolled for credit courses, including audit courses. This fee is in addition to the maintenance fee.
Program and Service Fee	A fee assessed for the following fees at an hourly rate: campus access (\$22.00), technology access (\$112.50), student activity (\$70.00), athletics (\$160.00), graduation (\$5.50), international education (\$10.00), debt service (\$89.00), postal service (\$15) and student government (\$4.00), and Health Service (\$25.00)
Orientation Fee	A one-time fee charged to first-time students enrolled for twelve (12) or more hours for credit in a semester (or six credit hours if first enrollment occurs in a summer term) or those students enrolled with an accumulation of 36 semester hours who have never been assessed the fee.
International Student Fee	An additional fee charged to students classified as "International" who are enrolled for credit courses, including audit courses.

- Refunds are calculated based on liable credit hours. Therefore, in some instances, a refund may not be applicable.

- Students dropping and adding courses on or after the first day of classes must process both the Add and the Drop ON THE SAME DAY and the Add must be processed first.

- RODP courses cannot be evenly exchanged with TSU courses when students drop/add on or after the first day of classes. RODP classes can be identified by section number R50. RODP courses are charged separately from TSU courses.
