

# Explanation of Fees

<b>Maintenance Fee:</b>	An enrollment or registration fee calculated based on the number of credit hours for which the student enrolls.
<b>Out-of-State-Tuition:</b>	A fee charged to students classified as non-residents of the state of Tennessee who are enrolled for credit courses, including audit courses. This fee is in <b>addition</b> to the maintenance fee.
<b>Program and Service Fee:</b>	A fee assessed for the following fees at an hourly rate: Campus access, technology access, student activity, athletics, graduation, international education, debt service, postal service, and student government.
<b>Orientation Fee:</b>	A one-time fee charged to first-time students enrolled for twelve (12) or more hours for credit in a semester (or six (6) credit hours if first enrollment occurs in a summer term) or those students enrolled with an accumulation of 36 semester hours who have never been assessed the fee.
<b>International Student Fee:</b>	An additional fee charged to students classified as International who are enrolled for credit courses, including audit courses.
