*On campus residents with more than thirty (30+) credit hours can participate in either the "Unlimited 7 + \$300 Dining Dollar" or the "Unlimited 5 + \$400 Dining Dollars."

*Residents of House of God and Residents Assistants (RA'S) are required to participate in the "150 Block + \$300 Dining Dollars" plan at a minimum.

*Commuter students with 12 on campus credit hours per semester will be required to participate in the Commuter Meal Plan for that semester. Any unused funds will be credited back to the student's account once they are no longer enrolled at the university.
