

Spring 2015 Important Dates

Fee payment/Confirmation deadline for PRE-REGISTERED students. Bills will not be mailed and will be available through your myTSU account beginning **December 1, 2014**. (*Class schedules will be deleted if fees are not paid* or students must *confirm* registration if their fees will be covered by scholarships, authorized deferments and/or financial aid by 4:30 p.m. at Cashier Window or by 6:00 p.m. on myTSU, **online payments only**). *Students may re-register during the regular registration period.*)

January 16, 2015

(Students who registered November 10, 2014 – January 16, 2015)

Fee payment/ Confirmation deadline for students who registered **January 20-23, 2015**. (Late - \$100 fee)

All fees must be paid in full on **January 28, 2015** (or students must *confirm* registration if their fees will be covered by scholarships, authorized deferments and/or financial aid) by 4:30 p.m. at Cashier Window or by 6:00 p.m. on myTSU, **online payments only**).

Early Registration for TBR, UT, State and TSU employees.

December 23, 2014 – January 16, 2015

NOTE: Fee Waiver Forms will not be processed for students who register prior to **December 1, 2014**. (*Class schedules will be deleted if fees are not paid* or students must *confirm* registration if their fees will be covered by scholarships, authorized deferments and/or financial aid by **4:30 p.m. on January 16, 2015**)

Regular Registration for TBR, UT, State and TSU employees. No Late Registration fee is assessed for these groups attending on a space-available basis.	January 20-23, 2015 (See Fee Payment Deadlines mentioned above.)

<p>Last day to withdraw from all classes or drop classes and obtain a 100% refund of liable credit hours.</p> <p>Note: Refunds are calculated based on liable credit hours. Therefore, in some instances, a refund may not be applicable. Students are encouraged to better plan their schedules and retain their full-time status on their way to a timely and successful graduation.</p> <p>Students dropping and adding a class on or after the first day of classes (January 20, 2015), must process both the Add and the Drop ON THE SAME DAY and the Add must be processed first.</p> <p>RODP courses cannot be evenly exchanged with TSU courses when students drop/add on or after the first day of classes (January 20, 2015). <p>Financial Aid Refunds disbursed.</p> <p>Refunds will be available on student ID cards for students who have registered, completed all paperwork in the Financial Aid Office, confirmed that they will be attending for the term on myTSU, and have actual aid credited to their accounts. Refunds will appear on the ID card (comdata account), within a 24 to 48 hour period from the date of the refund transaction that appears on your student account for the Fall term. Direct deposit is required if you are a freshman, transfer, or a returning student with a new ID card. Direct Deposits may take up to three business days to post to bank account. Students who do not sign up will receive their refunds via checks mailed to their permanent addresses on file, beginning February 16, 2015. To sign up, log on to myTSU and select <i>Student</i>, then <i>Refund Account Information</i>.</p>	<p>Beginning January 16, 2015 (after 9:00 p.m. for comdata accounts) Direct deposits may take up to three business days to post to bank account.</p>
