- Demonstrated leadership

- Resume
- Two letters of reference (one must be from a professor or school administrator)
- Three essay questions

Please respond to all of the following essay questions in 500 words or less. Each response should be typed, double-spaced with your name, address, contact information and social security number.

1. Explain how you have exhibited the Tennessee State University Motto—Think, Work & Serve.
2. Explain why you are interested in the retail industry and what attributes and abilities make you noteworthy of consideration of the Kohl's Retail Studies Scholarship?
3. During your college years what has been your greatest challenge or disappointment? What did you do to overcome this challenge or disappointment?
