Our Objective

ETS is one of the original TRIO Programs from the Equal Opportunity Act of 1964 and Higher Education Act of 1965. The United States Department of Education provides funding for these programs under Title IV. The Programs are committed to supporting and monitoring program participants throughout their secondary and postsecondary endeavors.

The ETS Program serves eight of the Metropolitan Nashville Public Schools (MNPS), Maplewood, Pearl Cohn, Stratford, and Whites Creek High Schools and Haynes, Jere Baxter, McKissack, and Stratford Lower Campus Middle Schools; with services such as tutoring, academic and personal counseling, college readiness activities, ACT prep, financial literacy, and career awareness. These schools are selected in clusters and have been identified to provide additional support.

Although ETS services are provided for the selected schools, we extend opportunities for students from any MNPS school to enroll. These students receive assistance on the TSU campus.
