## Curriculum

- This minor is perfect for students with a **commitment to serving their communities** and the desire to apply knowledge from their major to future employment in the nonprofit sector.
- The curriculum is a mixture of on-site courses (at the downtown Avon Williams Campus of TSU), hybrid, and online courses. Hybrid courses meet once every two weeks on-site; the remainder of course activities take place online, creating **schedule flexibility**.
- **Five three-credit courses are required as well as a six credit-hour internship.**
- **Courses usually include a valuable service learning component**, providing students with the opportunity to learn in a real-world setting while building connections in the regional nonprofit community.
