Dual Enrollment Online Program allows high school sophomores, juniors and seniors to earn college credits while still in high school. **Dual Enrollment is not the same as Dual Credit.**

Parent/Guardian Responsibilities

Parent or legal guardian shall complete the following:

Sign the Dual Enrollment Student/Parent Consent Form

- ⌚ Parents or legal guardian shall pay fees/tuition in the event the high school/agency does not cover any tuition cost
- ⌚ Parent shall assist with the collection of consent, consortium, health immunization form & the process of registration
- ⌚ Parents shall be aware that once the child turns 18 or attends a school beyond high school, parents/legal guardian can no longer access his or her records without the child's written consent. The Family Educational Rights and Privacy ACT (FERPA) protects the privacy of your child's education records.

Parent/Guardian Consent
