- Pay the I-901 fee
- Set up the appointment at the U.S. Embassy
- Get ready for your interview at the U.S. Embassy

Be on time Bring all the documents



- a) I-20: the original signed form we sent you,
- b) I-901: a copy of your payment,
- c) Visa appointment confirmation,
- d) Passport: Make sure all information is complete and you have a valid passport,
- e) The acceptance letter we sent you,
- f) Documents of your financial ability to pay for your travel, tuition and accommodation,
- g) Any other document to prove you plan to return to your country after your studies.



Immigration and visa issues are discussed in the cover letter which accompanied your confirmation packet from IEC - TSU.

Medical Information



Health Insurance

is required for all enrolled students at the University Make sure you have proper health coverage for all cases.

Required Immunizations

Tennessee State University requires proper immunization includes: Measles Mump Rubella (MMR) vaccine, Varicella (Chicken pox) vaccine, Tetanus-diphtheria vaccine, Hepatitis B (HBV) immunization, Meningococcal Meningitis vaccine (Mandatory if you are going to live in the dormitory)







Do not pack your immigration documents in your checked luggage.




Know your airline's baggage fees & policies




