TECTA Orientation

1,167 individuals completed TECTA Orientation classes. TECTA awarded 48 Center-Based TECTA Orientation Equivalency Certificates to high school students who completed Early Childhood Careers I and II courses.

Tuition Support for Higher Education

TECTA provided \$441,858 in scholarship dollars to eligible students statewide including students who work in Tennessee but live in bordering states.

Tennessee Child Care Online Training System (TCCOTS)

9,822 Certificates of Completion were granted, which represents over a total of 29,300 training hours.

1,103 academic seats were supported which resulted in the support of 548 students. 54 students graduated with a Technical Certificate or an A.A.S. in Early Childhood Education.
