## **TECTA** Orientation

1,206 individuals completed TECTA Orientation classes. TECTA awarded 55 Center-Based TECTA Orientation Equivalency Certificates to high school students who completed Early Childhood Careers I and II courses.



30 enrolled in the Administrator Academy and earned the Credential and 1 successfully completed all requirements for renewal.

4,085 academic courses were supported which resulted in the support of 1,340 students. Tuition Support for Higher Education

TECTA provided \$1,079,413 in academic tuition support for eligible students statewide including students who work in Tennessee but live in bordering states.

## Tennessee Child Care Online Training System (TCCOTS)

198,041 Completion Certificates were awarded.



Child Development Associate (CDA) Credential<sup>™</sup> Support TECTA sites provided funding for 1,794 students in CDA Prep courses and a total of 109 students earned or renewed their credentials.

19,252 Completion Certificates were awarded.
