The Honorable
Alexis M. Herman

Alexis M. Herman is the nation's 23rd Secretary of Labor. She was appointed by President Bill Clinton because "she understands the needs of workers and understands the challenges they face as we approach the 21st Century."



Ms. Herman brings more than two decades of leadership to the position of labor secretary. She has spent her career on the front lines of the changing workforce—as a business woman, a government executive, and a community leader—developing, promoting, and implementing policies to benefit workers and to increase opportunities and skills for the hard-to-employ.

Most recently, she served as assistant to President Clinton and director of the White House Public Liaison Office. In 1992, she served as the Deputy Director of the Presidential Transition Office.

As founder and president of A. M. Herman & Associates, Ms. Herman advised state and local governments, as well as private corporations during the 1980s. An expert on reducing and eliminating formal and informal labor market barriers, she guided corporations on human resource issues related to training, mentoring and reducing turnover. She also helped state governments link economic development activities to job creation and training strategies.

During the Carter Administration, Ms. Herman served as Director of the Women's Bureau at the U.S. Department of Labor, where she advised the administration and Labor Secretary Ray Marshall on workplace policy. She mounted new programs to help low-income and younger women with employment-related problems, and strengthened cooperation on women's concerns among private business, labor unions and government agencies. Before that, Ms. Herman was National Director of the Minority Women Employment Program of R-T-P, Inc., in Atlanta, where she established programs to place minorities in white-collar and nontraditional jobs.

In 1991, Ms. Herman was named Chief Executive Officer of the 1992 Democratic National Convention Committee.

A native of Mobile, Alabama, Ms. Herman began her career in 1969 as a social worker for Catholic Charities developing training opportunities for unemployed youth, unskilled workers and new entrants to the Mobile labor force at Ingall's Shipping, Inc., in Pascagoula, Mississippi. She graduated from Xavier University in New Orleans in 1969.

The scarlet is symbolic of the University Honors Program; the gold, of general scholarship. The cords are provided by the University Honors Program.

- ◆ Tennessee State University is home to two centers of excellence: the Center of Excellence for Research and Policy on Basic Skills and the Center of Excellence for Information Systems Engineering and Management.
- ◆ Tennessee State University is a major producer of African-American engineers. In the past 11 years, eight TSU engineering graduates have earned awards in various categories through the Black Engineer of the Year program, sponsored by *U.S. Black Engineer* magazine.
- ◆ Tennessee State University is one of a select number of universities nationwide to grant a bachelor's degree in Africana Studies. The program was launched in 1994.
- ◆ Tennessee State University is the only higher education institution in Nashville to have a chapter of Phi Kappa Phi, the most prestigious honor society encompassing scholars from all disciplines.
- ◆ Tennessee State University carries out nearly 100 public service projects each year, ranging from programs to help welfare recipients become self-sufficient to teaching area school children how to monitor the activity of stars through computers.




