# *Anthony J. Cebrun*

Anthony J. Cebrun is chairman, president and chief executive officer of Access Health Systems, Inc.; chairman and chief executive officer of Healthcare International Management Company; and president and chief executive officer of Tennessee Managed Care Network.

Cebrun is the founder of Healthcare International Management Company, an international management and consulting firm, which targets markets in Africa, Central America, Mexico, South America and the Caribbean Basin. Current activities of the company are focused in South Africa.

As president and chief executive officer of Access Health Systems, based in Nashville, Cebrun is responsible for the oversight and development of this emerging regional health care enterprise. Acting through its subsidiary, Medical Care Management Company (MC2), Access Health Systems develops and administers the daily operations of managed care organizations (MCOs) and health maintenance organizations (HMOs) in several southern states, including Tennessee and Mississippi. Through a recently acquired subsidiary, Medical Group Management Company, USA, Access Health Systems manages and develops primary care physicians and dental group practices in Tennessee and Texas.

With Tennessee Managed Care Network, an HMO, Cebrun oversees the operation and continued development of this private, non-profit, managed care company. Tennessee Managed Care Network (TMCN) is among the largest HMOs in the United States, serving nearly 300,000 members in the state of Tennessee. TMCN operates Access...MedPLUS, a health plan for the underserved and uninsured population. Access...MedPLUS is the second largest MCO providing services to TennCare, a Tennessee state-run Medicaid alternative insurance program.

Cebrun earned a bachelor of arts degree in sociology from Dillard University in 1970. In 1973, he earned a masters in public health degree from the University of Michigan. In 1979, he earned a juris doctorate from Woodrow Wilson College of Law, in Atlanta, Georgia.

### Tennessee State University

- Tennessee State University offers 43 bachelor's degrees and 26 master's degrees, and awards doctoral degrees in five areas: biological sciences, psychology, public administration, curriculum and instruction, and administration and supervision.
