Dr. Frederick S. Humphries Outstanding Leadership — Local, National and International

Frederick S. Humphries became the fourth president of Tennessee State University in January, 1975.

The Appalachicola, Florida, native graduated magna cum laude from Florida A&M University with a major in physical chemistry. He went on to earn a doctorate, with honors, from the University of Pittsburgh. Society memberships include Phi Lambda, Sigma Xi, Alpha Kappa Mu and Beta Kappa Chi.

Prior to coming to Tennessee State University, Dr. Humphries held a number of directorships and the position of vice-president with the Institute for Services to Education (ISE) in Washington, D.C.

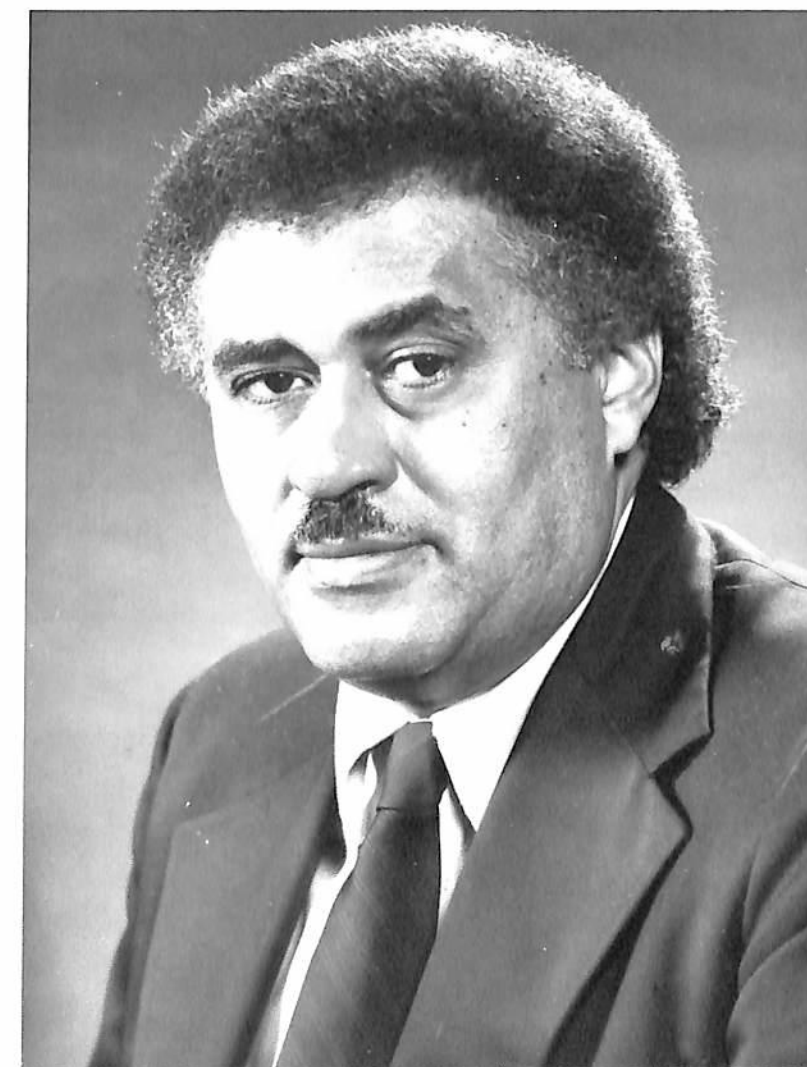
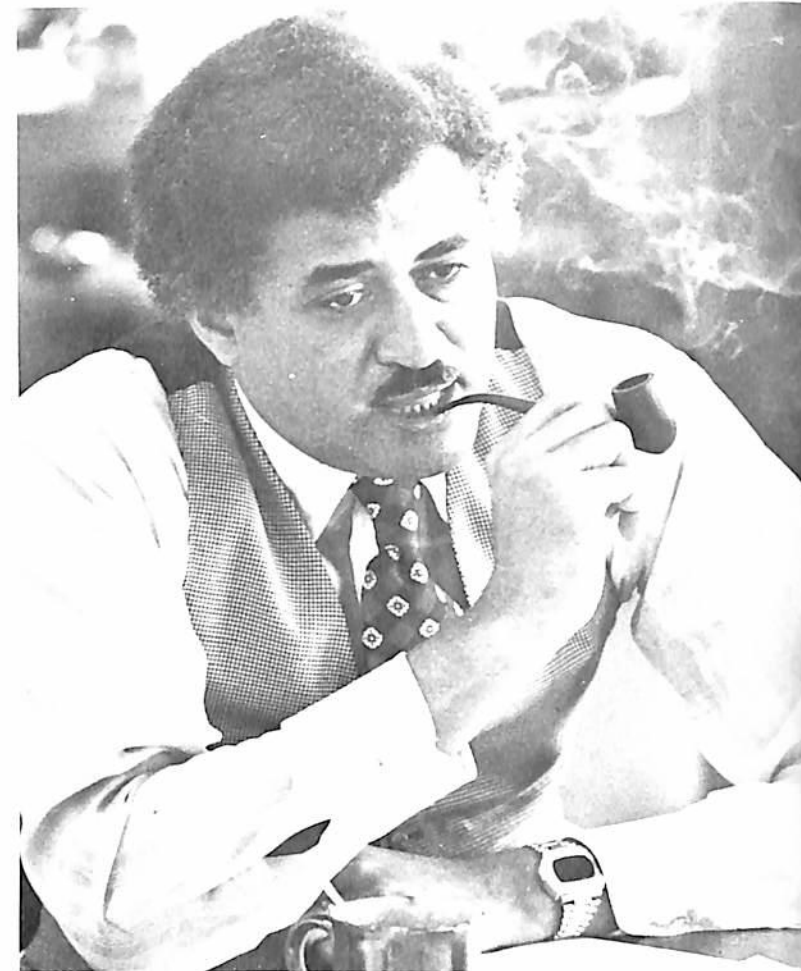
Since becoming President of Tennessee State University, Dr. Humphries has worked diligently to carry out the goals of the institution and to establish TSU as middle Tennessee's premier urban university.

While Tennessee State University has benefited dramatically from the leadership provided by Dr. Frederick S. Humphries over the last ten years, he has also provided leadership in educational and civic affairs in the community of which TSU is a part. He has taken seriously the demands of local, national, and international outreach that is a commitment of the institution, and he has worked tirelessly in its fulfillment. Locally, he has been a member of the Nashville Chamber of Commerce, Leadership Nashville, the Young Men's Christian Association, and a member of the Ethical Conduct Board for the Metropolitan Nashville Government. He has worked with the religious community as a supporter of the Interdenominational Ministers' Fellowship, an organization of black and white churchmen and churchwomen in Nashville. His council and advice played an important role in that organization's establishment of the College Trust Fund, a fund to assist students in the historically black institutions of Nashville. Through his speaking engagement, media interviews, and personal appearances at a wide variety of civic, religious, and community functions in Nashville, Dr. Humphries has created a very positive image of Tennessee State University as an institution of compassion and quality.

Although he has served as a member of a number of boards of directors over the last ten years, it has been his activities as a member of the Board of Directors of the National Association for Equal Opportunity in Higher Education (NAFEO) that the leadership of Dr. Humphries has been most persuasive and effective. As the Chairman of the Science Advisory Committee of NAFEO, he has led the Committee in a close working relationship with the national government and secured more than ten million dollars for both research centers at historically black institutions and for funds for academic enrichment for faculty and students.

The merger of Tennessee State University and the University of Tennessee at Nashville in 1979 enhanced the international dimensions of the University's research and academic offerings. Under Dr. Humphries' leadership, the institution is developing a masters degree in international programs to meet this mandate. The University is continuing its role in assisting in developmental work in the underdeveloped countries.

The wife of Dr. Humphries, the former Antionette McTurner of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, and their three children,



Frederick, Jr., Tonya, and Lawrence have joined their father in sharing energy and talent with the Nashville community. The Humphries family has given much as Frederick Humphries has devoted his genius and energy to a greater Tennessee State University, a greater Nashville and a greater Tennessee.

After 10½ years Dr. Humphries resigned his post at Tennessee State University June 30, 1985. Humphries accepted the presidency of his alma mater, Florida A&M University in Tallahassee, Florida.

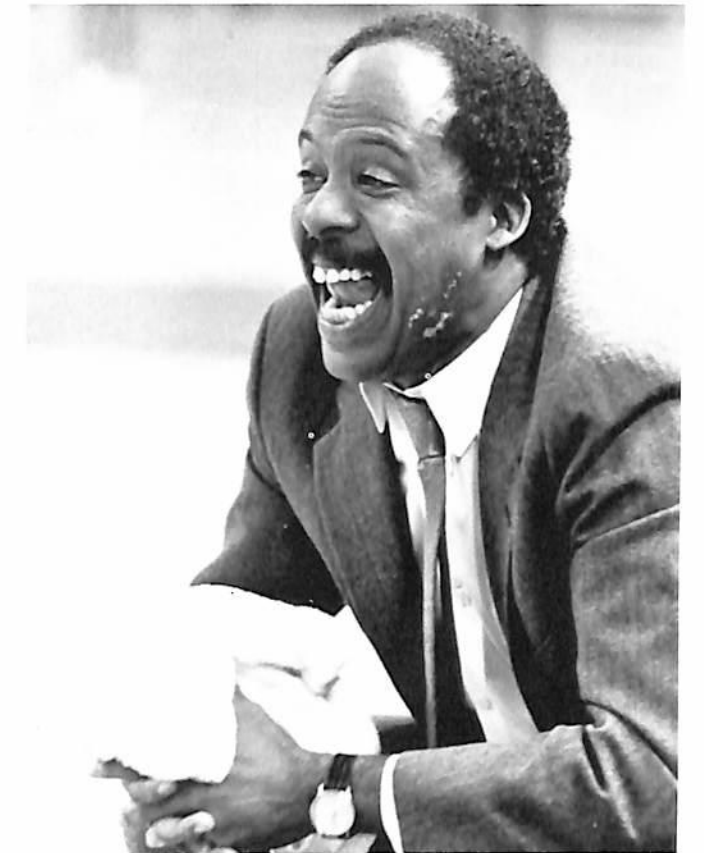
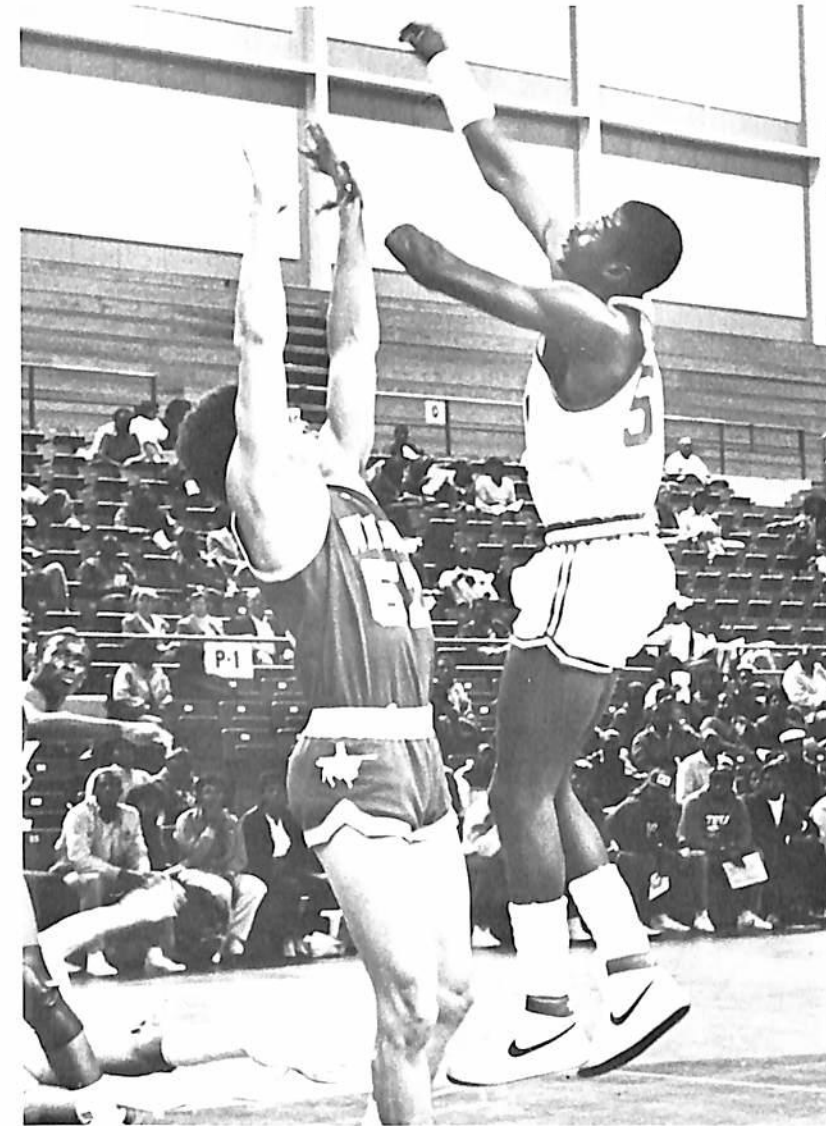


Head coach Ed. Martin is carried off the court after victory number 500. Martin later resigned before the season ended with a career winning percentage of .676.

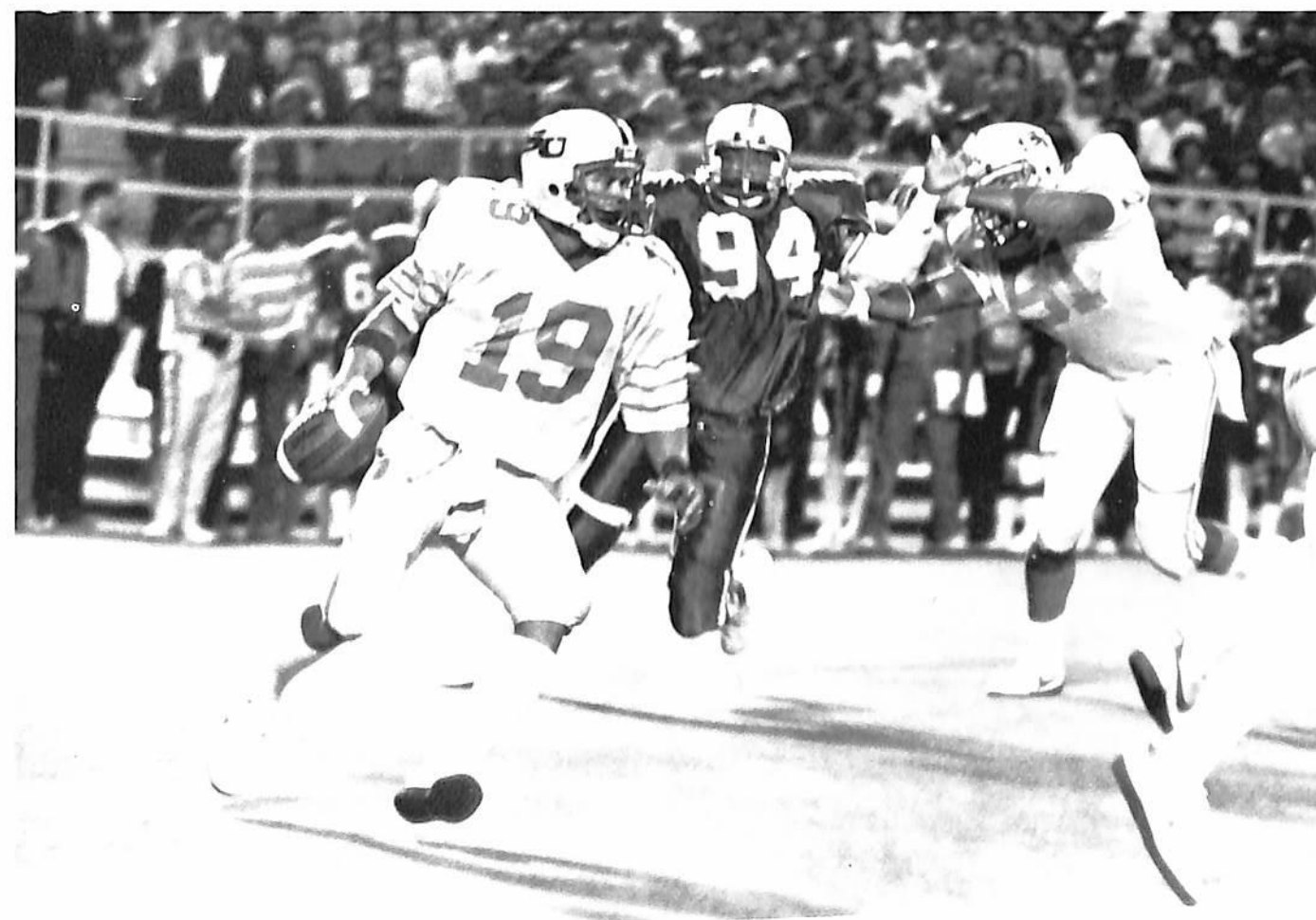

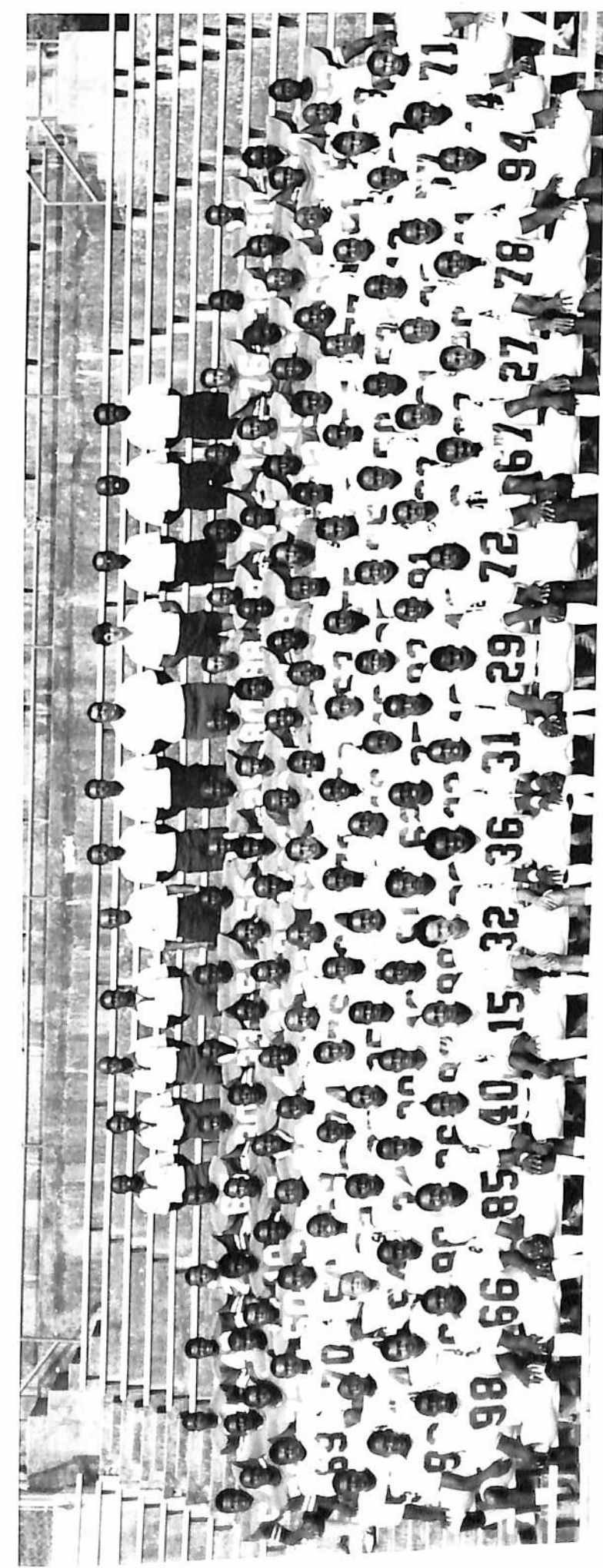

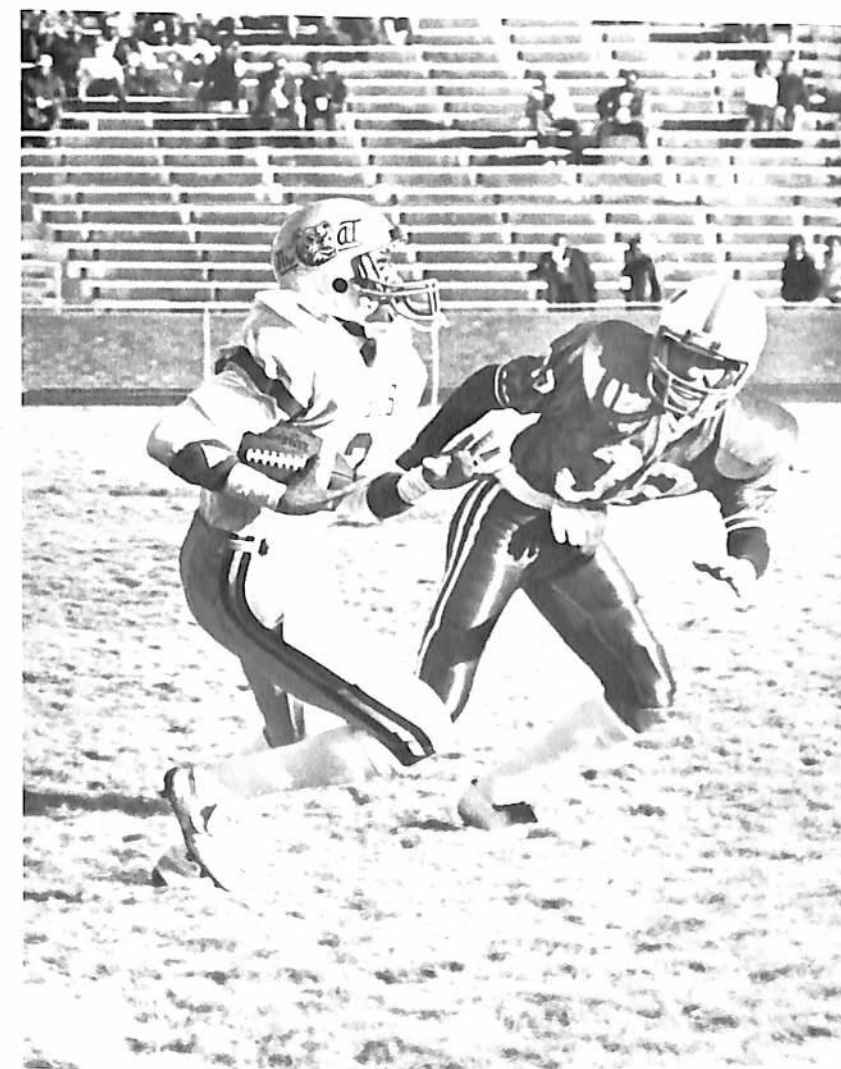
