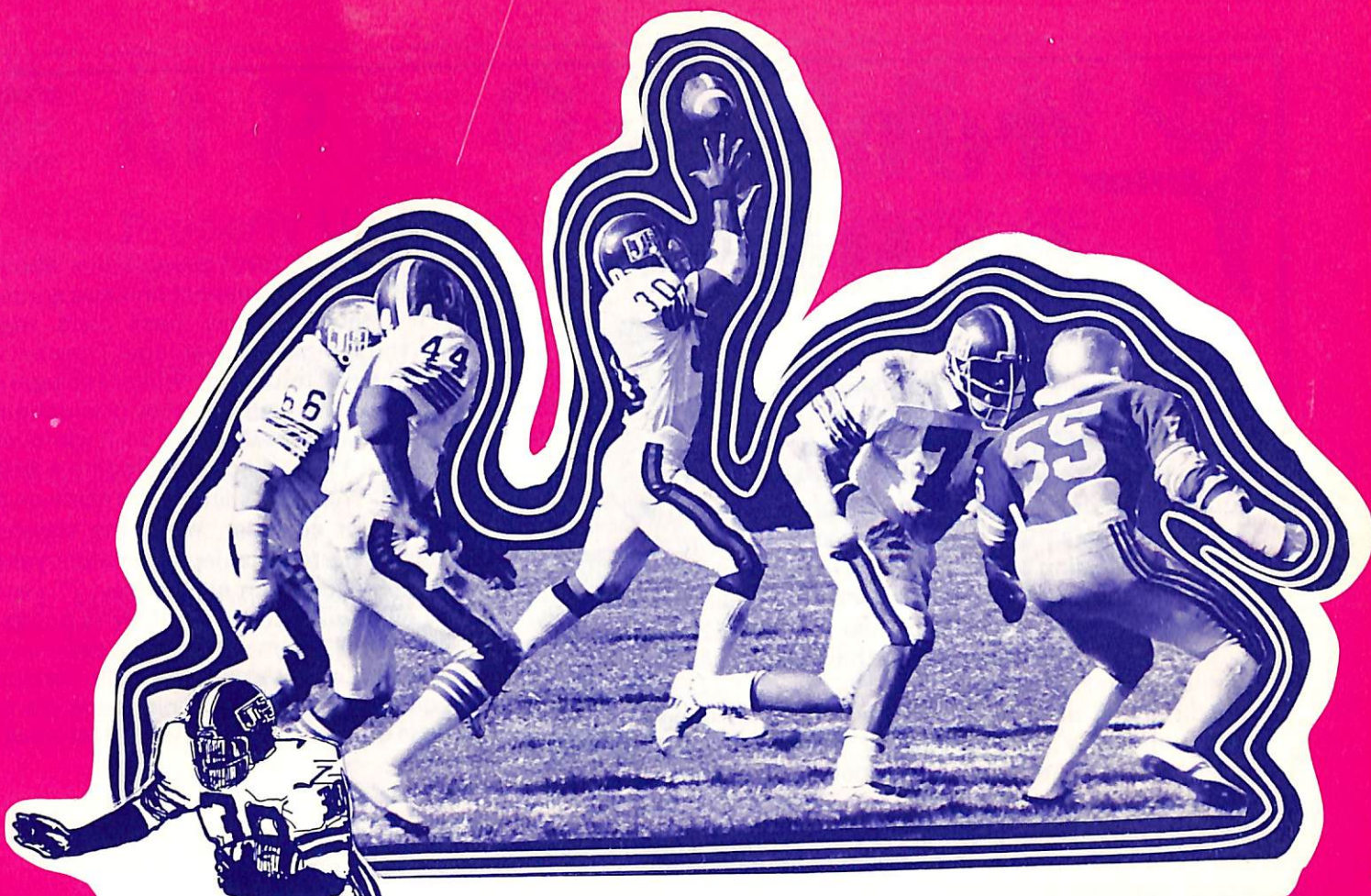

TODAY'S GAME

Today's game is appropriately dubbed "The Battle of the Tigers." There is always great excitement when these two teams play. Since renewing the series in 1975, the two teams have split four games. Jackson State ran roughshod over the Tennesseans in 1975 here in Mississippi Memorial Stadium, handing TSU it's first shutout loss in many years, 43-0. Head Coach John Merritt and his crew bounced back to take games two and three 23-20 and 17-7. Jackson, then evened the series in a 35-24 thriller up in Nashville.

This game pits Jackson's potent ground attack featuring Perry Harrington and Michael Stewart, who gained 91 and 89 yards respectively last week against Alabama State, against Tennessee's air force with transplanted Mississippian Joe Adams at the helm and receivers McDonald Oden and Mike Jones catching everything in sight.

Tennessee's defensive front seven rates about like Jackson's. Both have a suspect line and sound linebackers. It's the defensive back field that Tennessee has the pre-game advantage. They have three of four starters returning, while Jackson's secondary was completely wiped out by graduation.

Looking back at last week's close 14-7 win over Alabama State, the Tigers had to overcome a first quarter 7-0 deficit. The Tigers first score came on a 43 yard Keith Taylor scamper, while the second came when Buster Barnett hauled in an eight yard Taylor pass which capped an eleven play, 77 yard drive. Randle Lewis was good on both extra points.

Bright spots for the Tigers was the fine defensive play of linebackers Larry Werts and Phillip Perkins who were credited with 13 tackles a piece and Werts picked off a pass and returned it 15 yards last week.

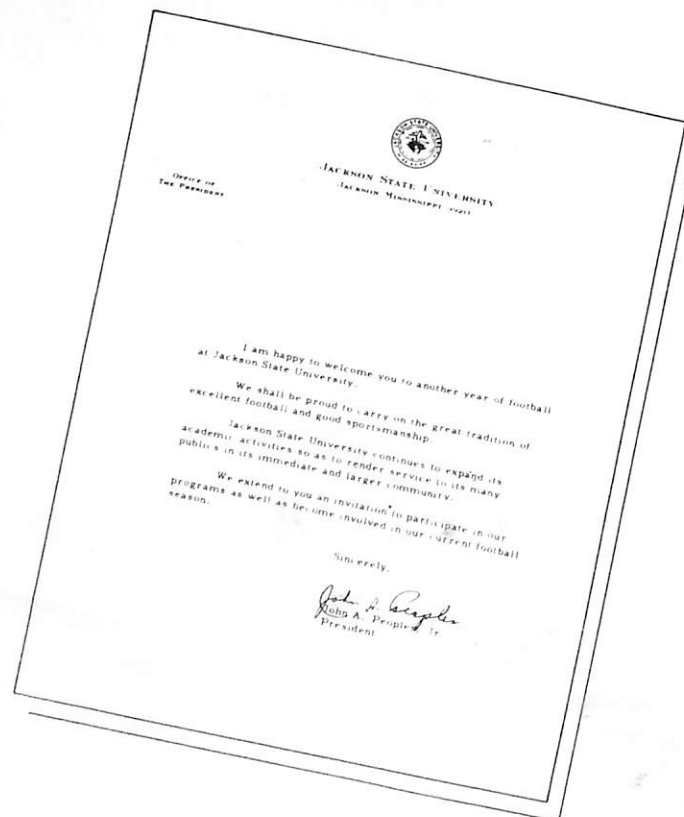

Greetings from the President



DR. JOHN A. PEOPLES, JR.

PRESIDENT

Dr. John A. Peoples, Jr. is entering his twelfth year as the chief administrator of Jackson State University and the entire University has enjoyed unprecedented success during this time. Dr. Peoples, who was appointed the sixth president of Jackson State University in 1967, is the first alumnus in the history of the institution elected to hold the position.

Since his inauguration, the growth and expansion of the University, physically and academically, have been extraordinary.

Jackson State's accelerated pace of expansion during this period has occurred in several major categories—explosive increases in enrollment, providing a broad spectrum of students; the significant elevation in the academic credentials of the faculty through advanced study and the acquisition of additional faculty holding the terminal degree; the implementation of the expanding curricula with improved approaches to the teaching and learning process; the securing and expending of larger budgets; the tripling of support personnel; the obtaining of new and renovated facilities—all of these have contributed to the progress made in the University's ability to provide improved service to all of its publics, both quantitatively and qualitatively.

Dr. Peoples is a native of Starkville, Mississippi. He received the bachelor's degree in mathematics from Jackson State University and the Masters of Arts and Ph.D. degrees from the University of Chicago.

Dr. Peoples is very active on many local, state, and national boards and commissions. He currently serves locally, on the Board of Directors of The Jackson Chamber of Commerce, as a commissioner on the Jackson Airport Authority, the Board of Trustees of United Way, Board of Directors, First Mississippi National Bank, Board of Trustees Piney Woods School, commissioner for Memorial Stadium. Nationally, he serves on the Board of Directors of American College Testing Corporation, Southern Regional Education Board, American Council on Education, and the National Association for Equal Opportunity in Higher Education.

For his athletic prowess at Jackson State, Dr. Peoples was inducted into the JSU Sports Hall of Fame in 1977 and he was inducted into the National Black Sports Foundation Hall of Fame in 1977. Also in 1977, he was presented the Distinguished American Award, Central Mississippi Chapter, National Football Foundation and Hall of Fame, Incorporated.

Dr. Peoples is married to the former Mary E. Galloway, a graduate of Jackson State. They have two children, Kathleen and Mark.

W. C. Gorden

W. C. Gorden is entering his third year as head coach of the JSU football team. Gorden, a native of Nashville, Tennessee, is a 1952 graduate of Tennessee State. He was a four year letterman in baseball, earned two letters in football and he was a member of the "T" Club.

Affable, personable, religious, hard worker and football enthusiast, are just some of the adjectives used to describe Gorden. He took over as interim head coach at JSU with two games remaining on the 1976 schedule. He has won 19 of 25 games since becoming head coach.

The position at Jackson State is Gorden's first as a college head football coach. He had ten years experience as an assistant coach at JSU including six as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator. He was the Tigers' head baseball coach in 1971 and 1972. His team won the SWAC championship in 1971 and 1972. His high school coaching experiences include head coaching jobs at Eva Gorden High at Magnolia, Mississippi and Temple High in Vicksburg where his team won the 1966 Big "8" Championship.

Gorden says that organization is the key to continuing the fine tradition of winning at JSU. His philosophy for success is to develop a good weight program, encourage academic excellence, and having a dedicated coaching staff who will establish rapport with the players and research new methods and techniques for developing football skills. He also believes in a hardnosed defensive ball club. Offensively, he favors a ball-control, option-oriented team.

Gorden and his wife Vivian, a Jacksonian, are the parents of two sons, Craig and Robin.
