

Individual performance time will be assigned prior to the competition. Participants should arrive at least <u>40 MINUTES</u> before performance time.

Repertory Requirements – Minimum of 8 minutes, not to exceed 15 minutes

Two memorized selections from contrasting periods of standard solo literature (simplified arrangements and/or concerto movements are not acceptable). Two or more short pieces from a set may be considered one selection.

- 1. Baroque: Bach Preludes and Fugues, two dances from a Suite; Scarlatti Sonata; one movement from a larger work by any Baroque composer.
- Classical: Sonata (Allegro movement) by Haydn, Mozart, Schubert, Beethoven or comparable works by other Classical composers.
- 3. Romantic: Works by Brahms, Chopin, Schumann, Liszt, or comparable composers.
- Twentieth Century: Compositions by Twentieth Century composers including Bartok, Ravel, Debussy, Margaret Bonds, Dett, Griffes, Ulysses Kay, Prokofieff, George Walker, Florence Price.

Eligibility Requirements

- Participants must be currently enrolled undergraduate students of a Historically Black College or University.
- 2. Participants must be between the ages of 18 and 25.

<u>Judging</u>

THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES IS FINAL. Adjudication sheets will be given to teachers.

Attire

Men - Suit and Tie

Women – Dress, dress pants suit, or skirt that covers the knee when seated. No mid-drift or low cut blouses or tops.
