ON-LINE COURSE APPROVAL FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS (F-1 VISA HOLDERS)

PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to set forth processes and procedures for international students to request on-line course approval. U.S. federal immigration regulations prohibit international students from taking more than one on-line course or 3 credit hours per semester that counts toward the full course of study requirement. Saudi Arabian students receiving a scholarship from the Saudi Arabian Cultural Mission (SACM) are prohibited from registering for on-line courses without prior approval.

POLICY

To ensure that international students comply with federal immigration regulations, an on-line course registration restriction has been placed on international students' accounts that prevents the registration of on-line courses without approval from the Office of International Affairs (OIA). This policy applies to any international student who is attending TSU on an F-1 student visa needing to register for an on-line course to meet degree completion requirements.

PROCEDURE

- 1. International Student On-line Course Approval Form
 - A. Student completes Section I of the form that can be found on OIA's website
 - B. Student emails form to academic advisor
 - C. Academic Advisor completes Section II of form and emails form to oia@tnstate.edu
 - D. OIA staff completes Section III of Form (Only for SACM Scholars)
 - a. OIA sends completed form to SACM for approval and copies the student
 - b. SACM will send financial guarantee to OIA and the student for specified course if approved

- 2. OIA sends request for student to be registered for approved course to appropriate department
 - A. Registration request is submitted to the Records Office for courses taught directly by TSU (section 98 courses)
 - B. Registration request is submitted to the Center for Extended Education for Regents courses
- 3. Student is enrolled in the requested course by appropriate department
