

Feature Overview

Course Planning Agent is a personalized self-service planning option for students and advisors that is available any time they need it. This feature must be enabled by your institution for it to be available and the student and advisor roles need the *Access the Course Planning Agent in Academic Planner* permission to access Course Planning Agent.




Student Use of Course Planning Agent

Students access Course Planning Agent in Academic Planner in Navigate360 Student desktop. Once in Academic Planner, students access Course Planning Agent in the left menu. In this example, Course Planning Agent is listed as the Course Planning Agent. Administrators can rename the Course Planning Agent at any time.



Uploading Documents to Course Planning Agent


To facilitate Course Planning Agent's advice, students can upload their degree audit or degree requirements documents to the bot. As mentioned in the <u>Course Planning Agent administration</u> article, your institution may also upload useful documents like course catalogs for Course Planning Agent for all students. The uploads in My Planner are for the student.




When uploading a document, students are limited to three options: a degree audit document, a degree requirements document, or other document. Other documents will be less useful to Course Planning Agent. There is a limit of three "other documents" when uploading.


Advisor Use of Course Planning Agent

To use Course Planning Agent as an advisor, the user first needs to open an assigned student's profile and then open the **Academic Plan** tab.






The Course Planning Agent launches in the center panel of Academic Planner.



Advisors then query Course Planning Agent to help create an Academic Plan for their students and send that plan to the student. Review <u>Creating an Academic Plan for Students in Next Generation Academic Planner</u> for more information about that process.
