Seed Grant Award Applications Open for Fall 2023



Seed Grant Award applications are currently being accepted for this academic year. As a part of TSU's efforts to move from an R2 to R1 Carnegie Classification, RSP offers Seed Grants of up to \$5,000 to research staff and faculty. The purpose of the award is to fund the initial phase of research and provide researchers with pilot study results to include in a larger proposal to an external funding agency.
