The symposium serves as a foundation to provide students with authentic experiences in presenting their research before advancing to regional, national, and international research symposia; and prior to professional careers.

All abstracts submitted for students will continue to the Abstract Review Committee. Abstracts will be "accepted" or "non-accepted" for presentation based on examination of the hypothesis or theory, objectives, design, materials and methods, results, and conclusions.
